For Jennifer Norseen, participating in this year's Dawson County Relay For Life was a no brainer.

Jennifer has family members and friends who have survived, and died, from the disease.

"I think the relay is good because it takes all the money raised and gives it to the American Cancer Society to find a cure for cancer," she said.

The fact that this year's event, July 12-13, is at Gothenburg's Lake Helen is another reason Jennifer wanted to participate and be a team captain.

Her mother, Jane Norseen, was diagnosed with breast cancer 12 years ago.

"She found out when my brother was a senior in high school," Jennifer said, noting that Jane is now a 12-year survivor and is on the supermarket team.

Jennifer's boyfriend, Jason Walls of Cozad, has also had cancer.
