## Classic cars gearing up for a cure Saturday

Fund-raiser coordinator April Headley of Eustis expects more than 100 classic car and bike entries from North Platte, Gothenburg, Lexington, Cozad and the surrounding area to participate.

"We may have a dragster and funny car that will fire up their engines this year," Headley said. The event also includes food and craft vendors, kids games, deejay entertainment and door prizes and contests.

"Everyone has memories of these classic cars and it's fun to see them all shined up and ready to roll instead of junked out in someone's pasture," Headley said. "Spectators walk through, look at the cars and just enjoy them."

The first 125 entries will receive a Dash Plaque and awards will go to: top 10; top Mopar, Ford, GM, pickup, ratrod, street rod and bike; under 21 and mayor's choice.

There will be door prizes for the exhibitors and contests for the spectators. For those who haven't been to a car show before, Headley said, "We will give prizes out all day long. For example, the first person to bring us a spark plug will win a prize. The first person with a certain kind of hat will win a prize or the first woman to bring a picture of their husband will win a prize. There will be trivia questions about cars and lots more."
