In a Dawson County Commissioners meeting Friday, Brandon Kjar presented Rasmussen's \$113,622 bid to the board.

Kjar, facilities maintenance supervisor of the sheriff's office, said Rasmussen, and its eight technical support people, can do all the work and provide support on the new unit.

Commissioners accepted the bid for the project estimated to start in June.
