

Gothenburg defeats Axtell.

It looked like Gothenburg might give Minden a run for its money last week in a volleyball triangular on the Swede home court.

With daunting net play and a stingy defense, the Swedes had Minden on the ropes in the first set of their game on Sept. 22.

Tied at 9-9, the Swede matched the Whippets play for play.

"Then suddenly it was like the lights shut off," said Gothenburg coach Mary Clark. "We stopped playing aggressively and things fell apart."

Minden took the match 25-16, 25-8.

When the Whippet began getting big blocks against the Swede hitters, everyone backed off, Clark said.

"I think it kind of took the wind out of our sales," the coach said, "and we never recovered."

Even senior hitter Emily Max, who has dominated the net for the Swedes all season, struggled getting the ball to fall.
