conduct an internal sportsmanship evaluation involving students, staff and the community.

complete athletic activities at all levels of competition throughout the year without having a coach or multiple athletes ejected.

In addition to Gothenburg, Lincoln Lutheran and Norfolk Catholic also received the NSAA sportsmanship award for the third straight year.
