Haymakers rally to win in the fourth

A fan for either team could have walked into the gym at the start of the fourth quarter and left after the final buzzer feeling like it was worth the price of admission.

Cozad caught fire in the final minutes of the game to take down the Gothenburg girls basketball team, 31-29.

Gothenburg didn't allow a point to the Haymakers for a span of nearly eight minutes in the second half. During that Cozad lapse, the Swedes surged ahead on a 12-0 run before going on a four-and-a-half minute drought of their own.
