

## Season's first win comes against Cozad

Gothenburg's Juniors picked up their first win of the season, but that was tempered somewhat by three losses during the week.

The Melons tripped up the Haymakers 13-5 on Thursday. A day earlier, Gothenburg fell to Broken Bow at home, 9-0.

Hershland rallied to beat the Melons 3-1 Saturday before Gothenburg was pounded at Broken Bow, 21-4.

The Melons entertain Overton Wednesday (tonight) and McCook on Thursday. Lexington and Holdrege come to town on Tuesday and Wednesday, respectively.

Consistent scoring hurts

Gothenburg gave up at least one run in all but one inning for a 9-0 loss to Broken Bow.

The visitors jumped out to a 4-0 lead after the first inning. They added a pair of runs in both the second and fourth frames and then closed out with a solo tally in the fifth.

The Melons had runners in scoring position just twice in the game.

Blake Riley singled in the first and then advanced to second on a two-out single by Bryce Kowalewski. A strikeout ended the threat.
