

Brady gets 51-39 win over W-P

PALISADE—It took the Brady girls basketball team about half of the game Friday night to get in sync.

When the Eagles found their rhythm, though, they were off and running to a 51-39 victory over Wauneta-Palisade in the season opener.

“We really didn’t play very well in the first half,” said coach Lance Arterburn. “We struggled to put the ball in the hole.”

Full-court pressure produced plenty of turnovers early but the Eagles couldn’t convert many to points in the first half.

Brady led 14-11 after the first quarter and trailed 26-25 at halftime.

Even in the third quarter when the Eagles kicked their defense up another notch, the girls struggled to score.

Brady trailed 32-31 heading into the fourth period but poured in 20 points in the final stanza to pull away.

“It’s a good thing we were making some layups late in the game because we weren’t hitting many other shots,” Arterburn said. “We’ll keep working on our shooting but I know we’re never going to shoot lights out. That’s why our defense has to be so good.”
