Support staff wages approved

Joseph R. Hewgley & Associates will begin drawing plans for a new science room and preschool on the east side of Brady Public School.

During a Monday night meeting, the Brady school board hired the North Platte architectural firm for planning services at a cost of \$25,560.

The board has to sign a contract before drawing plans are started. That time was unknown to superintendent Bill Porter.

Once that contract is signed and plans drawn up, a bid for contractors will be done to see who gets the building job.

On another matter, support staff wages were approved by the board for the 2013-14 school year.

Para-educators will earn between \$8.55 and \$11.20 an hour and custodians between \$9 and \$10.95. Bus drivers will make \$11.50 an hour and maintenance crew, \$14.50 hourly.

The head cook will make an hourly wage of \$11.45 and the assistant cook will be paid \$9.45 an hour. The secretary will make \$10 an hour and the bookkeeper will be paid \$13.30 hourly.

In other business, the board approved paying Lexington Glass \$25,000 for installing windows at Brady Public School.

The money will come out of the building fund but not until project completion.

The total cost of the windows project is \$148,000.

In other business, the board:

transferred \$30,000 from the general to the depreciation fund.

increased the charge for adult breakfast 46 cents to \$1.95 and lunch 25 cents to \$3.25. Student prices stayed the same.

approved buying stage curtains and hardware from Omaha Stage Equipment at a cost of \$10,547. The Talon Power Club has put in \$1,500 to help pay for the purchase.

set non-refundable computer and iPad user fees at \$50 for the school year.
